SWEETSTAKES

Juvenile Sweepstakes is open to all Finnish Lapphund puppies four months and under eighteen months of age regardless of place of birth. All dogs must be entered in one of the regular official classes. Dogs will be judges in one of the following eight classes (divided by sex):

4 months and under 6 months
6 months and under 9 months
9 months and under 12 months
12 months and under 18 months

For final judging the first-place puppy from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Best in Sweepstakes -rosette and 25% of total fees collected for the Juvenile Sweepstakes

Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes – rosette and 15 % of the total fees collected for the Juvenile Sweepstakes

First place winners in each class will divide the remaining 35% of the total fees collected for Juvenile Sweepstakes

25% of fees collected will be retained by the club to defray costs

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Finnish Lapphund dogs 7 years of age and over entered in a regular class or for exhibition only on the same day. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete provided they are also entered in exhibition only.

Dogs to be judged in one of the following classes (divided by sex)

7 years and under 10 years
10 years and over

For final judging the first-place winner from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. Best in Sweepstakes -rosette and 25% of total fees collected for the Veteran Sweepstakes Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes – rosette and 15 % of the total fees collected for the Veteran Sweepstakes

First place winners in each class will divide the remaining 35% of the total fees collected for Veteran Sweepstakes

25% of fees collected will be retained by the club to defray costs

SWEEPSTAKES AND JUNIOR HANDLING JUDGE

CAROLYN AYRE BIOGRAPHY



I grew up in a dog show home. My mother, Darlene Ayre, is a 50+ year and life member of the CKC, and a life member of the Red River Terrier Association, Cairn Terrier Club of Canada, and German Shepherd Dog Club of Manitoba.

I have been attending and participating in dog shows my entire life. I started as a junior handler, handling German Shepherd Dogs and Cairn Terriers. I have experience handling a variety of breeds, mostly herding dogs and terriers.

I was involved in my mother's breeding program, breeding Cairn Terriers under the kennel name Kinnayre. Together we bred 12 litters that produced multiple champions, including two that were the #1 Cairn Terrier in Canada.

I consider myself a life-student of purebred dogs. I am constantly researching, learning about and watching other breeds. My favourite book as a child was, Breed Visualizations, and I always looked forward to receiving and reading Dogs in Canada and Terrier Tidings magazines. I have never lost my love of learning about purebred dogs! My love of learning is serving me well as I work towards my first judging permit, which will be in terriers.

I have worked behind-the-scenes and on the front lines of shows, specialties, trials, tests, sanction matches and fun matches since I was young. My Mom was a show secretary for several clubs, and I have fond memories of helping her: from organizing entries, preparing judging schedules, to counting and packing rosettes and ribbons. I am currently the Secretary for Evelyn Kenny Kennel and Obedience Club. I have previously been on the Board of the German Shepherd Dog Club of Canada and the German Shepherd Dog Club of London (Ontario).

In addition to conformation, I train and trial in obedience, rally obedience and scent detection.

In my "real life" I am a lawyer employed by the Alberta Crown Prosecution Service as Crown Prosecutor, where I specialize in Internet Child Exploitation prosecutions.

JUNIOR HANDLING

Friday August 8, 2025, following the Conformation Classes

Entries will be accepted at the Show Secretary's desk up to 1 hour prior. The following classes will be provided:

Pee Wee (non-competitive) 4 – 6 years, Junior Novice 7-10 years, Junior Open 7-10 years, Novice 11-14 years, Intermediate 11-14 years, Senior Novice 15 -18 years, Senior Open 15-18 years.

Competition is open to all Junior handlers between the ages of 4 and up to 18 years. Dogs handled by the juniors must be entered in a Regular Conformation class or in Exhibition Only at this event.

Pee Wee – participation ribbon and suitable prize Best Overall Handler – rosette and suitable prize 1st thru 4th in each class – rosette and suitable prize

Please note that effective January 1, 2016, in accordance with Section 3.4.1 of the Junior Handling Rule & Regulations, Junior Handlers will be required to apply for a CKC for a Junior Handling Number. Section 3.4.1 Junior Handler with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling Event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked.

CLASSES

The following Regular CKC classes divided by sex will be offered:

Junior Puppy – This class shall be for any dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

Senior Puppy - This class shall be for any dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12 – 18 Months – This class shall be for any dog 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

Canadian Bred – This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. Champions of any county excluded

Bred By Exhibitor – This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by the owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-owner of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

Open Class – This class shall be for all dogs

Veteran Class – This class is for dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of the show. Class will be divided 7 yrs to under 10 yrs and 10+ yrs The winner of each class in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only – This class shall be for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A listed dog may be moved to the Specials Only class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC individual or Event Registration number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only class must be received by the Show Secretary one hour prior to the show on the day concerned. Listing fees will not be refunded.

Award of Merit – May be awarded for every 10 dogs competing for Best Of Breed

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Exhibition Only – All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class May Not Compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades only.

Baby Puppy – This class is for dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

Stud Dog – This class shall be comprised if the stud dog and two or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a regular class.

Brood Bitch – This class shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog class. The Brood may be spayed.

Owner/Handler – Owner must handle the dog at all levels.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age, which have been sexually altered by a veterinary procedure. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class will be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed, divided by sex.

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place from each sex will be declared Winners and the second-place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will compete for Best Altered in Breed.

Attention US Exhibitors: Current exchange rate favours the American dollar. To take full advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they must be payable in US funds, and for the full amount of the entry. Please do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian fund, or "at par" as such items are not readily cleared through the bank. Your co-operation is appreciated.

ATTENTION: ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - ERN NUMBERS All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard number, (expiry date, cardholders name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. ERN number must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.

Temporary Competition Numbers or (TCN) – A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN off (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application, and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC by mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, score, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
2. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER CLOSING DATE. Receipts, judging schedules, and exhibitors' passes will be e-mailed
3. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
4. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
5. SHOW PRECINCTS: Whitemud Equine Learning Centre Assoc., excluding the commercial booth space.
6. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
7. 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
8. See the Edmonton Kennel Club Premium list for benching and RV information.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

| Dogs competing* | 1 | 2 | 3 to 5 | 6 to 9 | 10 to 12 | 13 or more |
|------------------|---|---|--------|--------|----------|------------|
| Points allocated | 0 | 1 | 2 | 3 | 4 | 5 |

* Includes the dog award Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be **not** in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.

The new system provides for additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level, if a dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

| 3 breeds | 2 | 1 | 0 | 0 |
| 2 breeds | 1 | 0 | 0 | 0 |
| 1 breed | 0 | 0 | 0 | 0 |

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single show.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level

(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

15.2.4 GRAND CHAMPION BRONZE (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. a. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand championship. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. c. Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021, may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

15.2.5 GRAND CHAMPION SILVER (GChS) a. The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.2.6 GRAND CHAMPION GOLD (GChG) a. The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. b. To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

15.3 GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT (GCh.Ex) 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Champion Silver title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.

15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a. one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed National specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b. three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c. a CKC performance title from any CKC event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance Title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward it to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honored up until July 1, 2022.

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"
