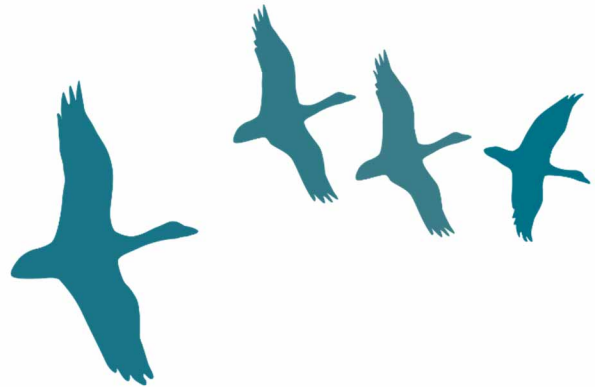

JUNIOR HANDLING (CONFORMATION)

Saturday August 8th

TIME: Will be published in the judging schedule

JUDGE: Neal Goodwin, Altair Flat-Coated Retrievers, CT, USA

Held under CKC Rules. Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the Show Secretary. A Junior Handler may compete with any dog entered in the Specialty Show provided he/she has the consent of the owner or agent to do so. If necessary, due to conflict, substitution of dog will be allowed. Dogs being used in the competition, **MUST BE OF APPROPRIATE SIZE AND TEMPERAMENT FOR THE JUNIOR HANDLER**. Junior Handlers, with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked.

Rosettes will be offered for BEST OVERALL and RESERVE BEST OVERALL. Prizes and rosettes will be offered for 1st to 4th placements in each class.

CONFORMATION CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following CKC classes, divided by sex will be provided:

Junior Puppy - for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age

Senior Puppy - for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age

12-15 Months - for dogs 12 months of age but under 15 months of age

15-18 Months - for dogs 15 months of age but under 18 months of age

Canadian Bred - for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded

Bred By Exhibitor - for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards

Open - for all dogs

Field Dog Started - Dogs who have earned a WC or WCI; or a Junior Hunter title; or a JFTR or QFTR title or pointed in a field trial (official CKC titles only)

Field Dog Advanced - Dogs who have earned a WCX title; or one or more Senior or Master Hunter legs; or a FTCH or AFTCH title (official CKC titles only)

Veteran 7 to 9 - for dogs 7 years of age but under 9 years of age

Veteran 9 to 11 - for dogs 9 years of age but under 11 years of age

Veteran 11 plus - for dogs 11 years or older

NOTE: Veteran class dogs and field dog class dogs do not compete for winners, but the winners of each class (M, F) will compete for best of breed. (Field Dogs, Veterans). Dogs competing in veterans and field dog classes may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only - for dogs that are registered individually, in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN number and have attained Championship status. The entry of a 'listed' dog is not allowed.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age that have been spayed or neutered. Points MAY NOT be carried from regular competition judging to the Altered Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed in the regular classes.

Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female.

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes; the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners, and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES

Non-regular classes (Dogs must also be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only).

Baby Puppy - for dogs 4 to 6 months old.

Exhibition Only - dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in the non-regular classes.

Stud Dog & Get - Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brood Bitch & Progeny - Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

Brace - Two dogs, not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead.

OBEDIENCE AND RALLY CLASSES OFFERED

OFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

PRE-NOVICE An elective class for dogs that have not earned the title of CKC PCD or CD. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. Not eligible for HIT competition.

NOVICE A For dogs that have not earned the title of CKC CD. Only one dog per handler allowed.

Handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family member. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CKC CDX title may NOT handle a dog in this class.

NOVICE B For dogs that have not earned the title of CKC CD. A person may enter more than one dog.

Dogs may be handled by any person. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

NOVICE C For dogs that have earned the title of CKC CD or higher. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. Not eligible for HIT competition.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE An elective class for dogs that have earned the title of CKC CD or higher. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. Not eligible for HIT competition.

OPEN A For dogs that have earned the title of CKC CD but have not earned the title of CKC CDX. Only one dog per handler allowed. Handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family member. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CKC OTCH title may NOT handle a dog in this class.

OPEN B For dogs that have earned the title of CKC CD or higher. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B class at any one trial. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial.

UTILITY A For dogs that have earned the title of CKC CDX but have not earned the title of CKC OTCH. A person may enter more than one dog. Handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family member. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CKC MOTCH title may NOT handle a dog in this class.

UTILITY B For dogs that have earned the title of CKC CDX or OTCH. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. No dog may be entered in both Utility A and Utility B class at any one trial. A dog may also be entered in the Open B Class in the same trial.

EXHIBITION ONLY For dogs 6 months and over, not competing in official classes.

UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

BRACE For any two dogs that have earned the title of CKC CD or higher. The same person need not own both dogs. Dogs may be handled by any person. The exercises shall be performed as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Brace Class must be entered in an official class or for Exhibition Only

VETERANS For dogs that have earned the title of CKC CD or higher AND are 7 years old or older on the day of the trial. Dogs may be handled by any person. The exercises shall be performed as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Veteran Class must be entered in an official class or for Exhibition Only.

SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED. Please include Jump Height on entry form.

OFFICIAL RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

RALLY NOVICE A For dogs that have not earned the title of CKC RN title or any CKC obedience title other than the PCD. A person may enter more than one dog. Handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family member. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CKC CDX title or a CKC RA title may NOT handle a dog in this class.

RALLY NOVICE B For dogs that have not earned a qualifying score in the CKC RA class. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE An elective class for dogs that have earned the title of CKC RN or higher. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. A dog may compete in this class indefinitely.

RALLY ADVANCED A For dogs that have earned the CKC RN title but have not earned the CKC RA title or any CKC obedience title other than CKC PCD. A person may enter more than one dog. Handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family member. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CKC CDX title or CKC RE title may NOT handle a dog in this class.

RALLY ADVANCED B For dogs that have earned the CKC RN title. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial. A dog may compete in this class indefinitely.

RALLY EXCELLENT A For dogs that have earned the CKC RA title but have not earned the CKC RE title or any CKC obedience title other than CKC PCD. A person may enter more than one dog. Handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family member. Any person who has exhibited a dog that has earned a CKC CDX title, CKC RM title or CKC RAE title may NOT handle a dog in this class.

RALLY EXCELLENT B For dogs that have earned the CKC RA title. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial. A dog may compete in this class indefinitely.

RALLY MASTER For dogs that have earned the CKC RE title. A person may enter more than one dog. Dogs may be handled by any person. A dog may compete in this class indefinitely.

SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED. Please include Jump Height on entry form.

UNOFFICIAL RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASS

RALLY NOVICE BRACE For any two dogs that have earned a title of CKC RN or higher. The same person need not own both dogs. Dogs may be handled by any person. The exercises shall be performed as in the Rally Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Brace Class must be entered in an official class or for Exhibition Only

A Bitch in season may not compete in Obedience or Rally Trials.

Outdoor Rally ring size = 65' x 45'

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes Classes (divided by sex):

6 to 9 months

9 to 12 months

12 to 15 months

15 to 18 months

Dogs entered in Puppy Sweeps must be entered in a Regular Class at this show.

Veteran Sweepstakes Classes (divided by sex):

7 to 9 years

9 to 11 years

11 years and over

Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition Only at this show. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete.

Gundog Sweepstakes Classes (divided by sex):

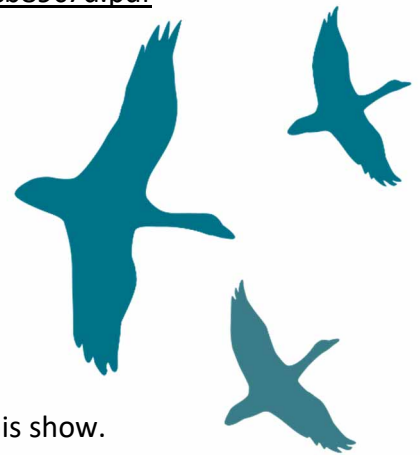
Started – WC or JH title from Canada or the US

Intermediate – Canadian WCI or American WCX title

Advanced – Canadian WCX or SH or higher title, American SH or higher title

Dogs entered in Gundog Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition Only at this show. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete.

For all Sweepstakes: Winners from each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. Rosettes will be offered for 1st to 4th place in each class.



SWEEPSTAKES AWARDS

Prize Money will be divided as follows in each sweepstakes: Best in Sweepstakes: Rosette, Prize, & 30% of total entry fees collected for Sweepstakes. Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes: Rosette, Prize, & 20% of total entry fees collected for the Sweepstakes. 1st in Class: 25% of fees collected for the relevant class. Rosette and/or Prize for 1st-4th. The remaining 25% of fees collected will be retained by the FCRSC to defray costs.

Be proud of your own dog - show it off in Sweepstakes!

The FCRSC Sweepstake events provide a great opportunity for owners and breeders to showcase the potential of their young dogs and the longevity and soundness of their veteran dogs. The FCRSC strongly encourages all owners to handle their own puppies, gundogs and veterans in sweepstakes, whenever possible. If you are physically unable to show your own dog on the move, you may bring a "runner" into the ring to move the dog for you.

ATTENTION: ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - ERN NUMBERS All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard number, (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of your ERN. ERNs must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - MUST be obtained from the CKC prior to entering any CKC event. TCNs replace the previous system of entering events with dogs as "listed" and allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN, MCN, ERN or CKC registration number is required for Baby puppies to enter, however the TCN entry fee is NOT paid on a baby puppy entry. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
2. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten-day period preceding the trial, is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
3. ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER CLOSING DATE. Receipts, judging schedules, and exhibitor passes will be e-mailed.
4. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
5. SHOW PRECINCTS: Whitemud Equine Learning Centre Assoc., excluding the commercial booth space.

6. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash of a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area. You are responsible for cleaning up after your dog.

7. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that “these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.”

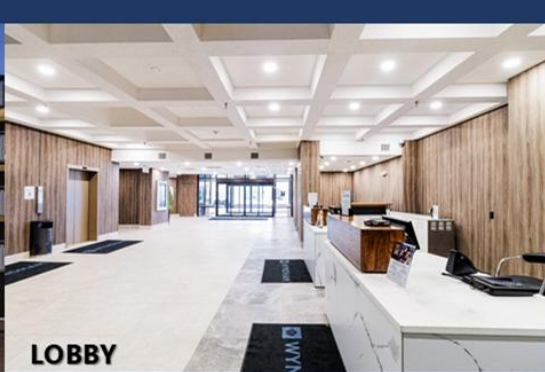
